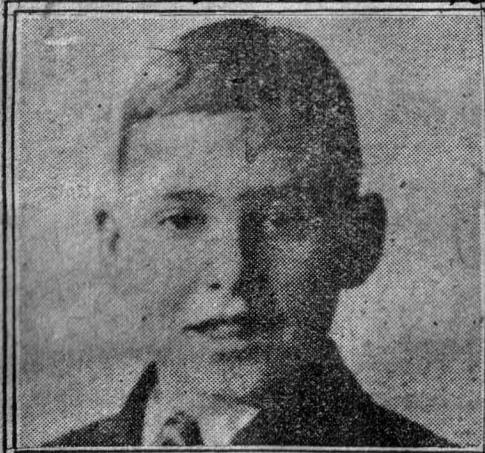

FOUR YOUNG VICTIMS OF TEWKSBURY BOAT ACCIDENT WHO LOST THEIR LIVES IN ROUND POND.

Four families were bereaved by the accident when the quartet of children embarked in a boat not yet seasoned and which quickly filled with water and sank. The children screamed for aid, but sank from sight before several youths in another boat could reach them.
